The waiting list and expectations

Kvinderegensen's dorm rooms are offered evenly between female and male students. Therefore, we apply two separate waiting lists whose lengths vary throughout the year. Normally, the waiting list for women is longer than the one for men. This is why female students in general are offered accommodation after 1½ - 2½ years and men typically wait 1 - 2 years.

General information about Kvinderegensen

Kvinderegensen is a student housing facility associated with the University of Copenhagen. There are 58 rooms and an apartment for the gatekeeper. Kvinderegensen was established in 1932 and offered student housing solely for women. In 1973, men were allowed to apply for residence and ever since, we have sought an even sex distribution in the house. Moreover, we want to house students from different programmes and so have versatile *kitchens* (kitchen: social community). Eight to nine people share kitchen, bathrooms and toilets.

We have a splendid garden with a greenhouse, a ballroom, a large multi-purpose room with table tennis and football, a simple gym and a music room, a library and a television room, laundry, attic and bicycle storage. The rooms are app. 14-16 m² and are equipped with a sink, build-in closet, internal phone and internet access.

The rent is 2.492 kr. per month incl. a joint contribution (30 kr.). The security deposit is 7.041 kr. and is paid with the first rent.

As a fellow at Kvinderegensen, you share many practicalities every day. However, our student house is also a capable, social community. Of course you need time and space to be you, to study and have visitors etc. but at Kvinderegensen we also spend time together. We chatter in the kitchen, arrange and participate in parties, we go to the movies and to the theater. We are active residents. Every term, we host a party for all dwellers and friends. The ballroom is neatly decorated according to a theme, we eat fine food and dance the night away. In august, we host a one-day music festival in our garden for residents and their friends. We hope that you will grant us with openness, drive and new ideas for our home.

Documentation for study activity

You are required to document your ongoing studies at the University of Copenhagen. The documentation can either be an exam registration, a print of passed exams (within the past year) or a copy of your acceptance letter from the University of Copenhagen if you just have begun your studies and have not yet been able to register for exams.

Kvinderegensen does not evaluate and rank incoming applications. One is simply given a place on the waiting list based on the date we receive your application.

Memo list

1. Inform Kvinderegensen if your contact informations change, ei. address, e-mail and phone number. Suddenly, a room is vacant and we will use the given information to contact you.
2. Every year in December, you are required to confirm that you want to keep your seniority on the waiting list. Your application is discarded if you fail to do so.
